This letter is our final response to your Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry (CDC/ATSDR) Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request of March 23, 2003, assigned #20-01010-FOIA, for:

Documents reflecting the approximate total number of individuals in the United States who have been infected with COVID-19 as of a date on or around this request (including individuals who are asymptomatic or paucisymptomatic). [COVID-19]

Please note that Data include both confirmed and presumptive positive cases of COVID-19 reported to CDC or tested at CDC since January 21, 2020, with the exception of testing results for persons repatriated to the United States from Wuhan, China and Japan. State and local public health departments are now testing and publicly reporting their cases. In the event of a discrepancy between CDC cases and cases reported by state and local public health officials, data reported by states should be considered the most up to date as the date is calculated as illness onset date if known.
