Dear Mr. Siri:

This letter is in response to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request submitted to the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) on behalf of your client, the Informed Consent Action Network (ICAN). OMB assigned this FOIA request tracking number 2021-420.

Pursuant to our email exchange on November 4, 2021 about the scope of your FOIA request, OMB is making its first rolling production. Specifically, OMB has reviewed 300 potentially responsive records and identified 34 responsive documents, of which OMB is releasing 19 documents with redactions. These 19 documents include redactions made pursuant to FOIA Exemption 6, U.S.C. § 552(b)(6). Exemption 6 protects against disclosure of information that would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy such as email addresses and telephone numbers. As for the remaining 15 documents, OMB is withholding these documents in full because they consist of duplicates.

OMB will continue to review documents in this matter and intends to respond with its next production on or before February 14, 2022.
