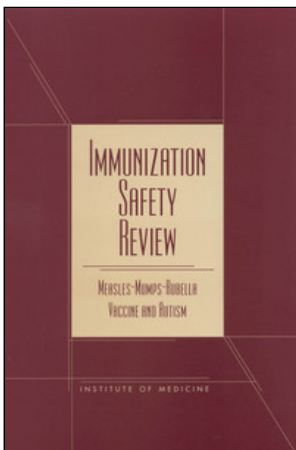

What We Do

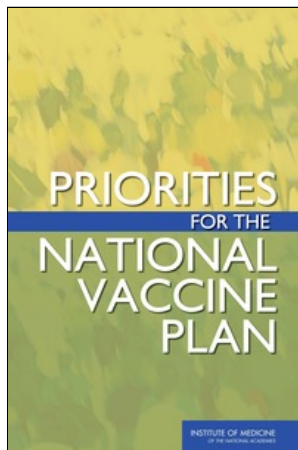
HMD's consensus studies and convening activities around vaccines explore access, safety, scheduling, and potential adverse effects, among other areas.

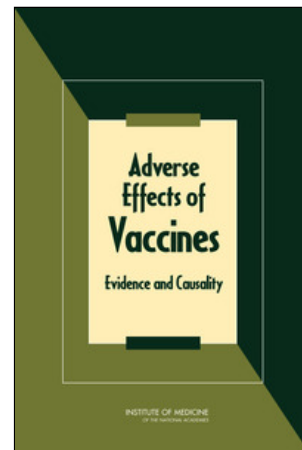

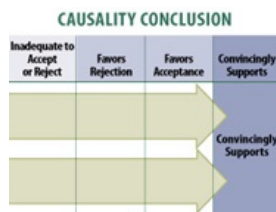
