DISMISSAL WITHOUT PREJUDICE UPON DEFENDANTS' REPEAL OF THEIR INFLUENZA VACCINE MANDATE

WHEREAS, on December 18, 2020, Plaintiffs commenced this action along with a motion for a preliminary injunction seeking to enjoin Defendants from enforcing their mandate that those in preschools, primary schools, secondary schools, and post-secondary institutions obtain an influenza vaccine as a condition of attending school;

WHEREAS, Defendants' opposition to the motion for a preliminary injunction was due to

be filed on January 15, 2021;

(WHEREAS, on January 15, 2021, Defendants repealed their influenza vaccine mandate such that no child or adult in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts would be required to receive an influenza vaccine to attend preschool, primary school, secondary school, or a post-secondary institution: THEREFORE, in accordance with Mass. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(i), and pursuant to the repeal of Defendants' influenza vaccine mandate, Plaintiffs Tamar Massoyan-Artinian and Madison Schiltz voluntarily dismiss without prejudice the above-entitled action as to Defendants Monica Bharel, in her official capacity as Commissioner of the Massachusetts Department of Public Health, and the Massachusetts Department of Public Health, expressly reserving any and all rights to reassert any and all claims raised in this action in the event Defendants seek to reinstitute any influenza vaccine mandate at any time in the future.
