information regarding vaccine safety issues for free, including through its website, I a weekly health news and talk show, 2 and through press events and releases. ICAN is seeking the information in this PIA request to allow it to contribute to the public understanding of the government's vaccine safety programs, including the government's efforts to promote vaccine safety. We therefore request that we be provided with all non-exempt portions which are reasonably segregable. Such statements may help to avoid unnecessary litigation.

Access to the requested records should be granted within ten (10) business days. Failure to respond in a timely manner shall be viewed as a denial of this request and ICAN may commence a civil action.
