This letter is in response to your Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry (CDC/ATSDR) Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request of April 10, 2018, for respective copy of the Department of Health and Human Services and 42 U.S.C. §300aa-27(c) (IR#0012). Your May 2, 2018 letter to CDC narrowed your request to" only produce the last report that HHS has submitted to Congress pursuant to Section 300aa-27(c)."
